Dear Madam/Sir,

The American Chamber of Commerce to the EU (AmCham EU) continues to condemn Russia's invasion of Ukraine as a clear violation of international law and a threat to the fundamental values we stand for – human dignity, democracy and the rule of law. AmCham EU members fully support the reaction of the EU and international community in the wake of Ukraine's aggression and are committed to complying with existing sanctions and obligations.

At the same time, AmCham EU would like to express their concern regarding a requirement introduced by the 11^{th} package of sanctions – Article 3g – to provide evidence of the country of origin of steel and iron materials and products made of such material may not be imported into the EU if they: (i) originate in Russia or (ii) have been exported from Russia.

Since the evidence requirement is due to come into effect on 30 September 2023, we want to underline the uncertainties that it generates across sectors. It is unclear how this requirement will be enforced, and particularly how it will be applied to cover iron and steel finished and semi-finished products manufactured or purchased prior to the effectiveness date. Our concerns are focused on Article 3g(d):

'For the purposes of the application of this point, at the moment of importation, importers shall provide evidence of the country of origin of the iron and steel inputs used for the processing of the product in a third country[.]'

With this letter, we would like to draw your attention to the following issues:

- Delays in Customs clearance: as an example, a significant number of Aerospace and Defense (A&D) companies' imports primarily fasteners and other low value items into the EU may be required to ship with Mill Test Certificate (MTCs), or other documentation, sufficient to meet the Article 3g requirement. It is not yet clear if this documentation will be requested for each shipment at the time of import clearance into the EU. To the extent such documentation does not accompany a shipment or is not sufficient to satisfy the requirements of Article 3g, delays in Customs clearance are likely to result.
- MTCs claimed, in some instances, as proprietary information: customers may request information from companies regarding manufacturing to meet these requirements and/or assess business risk. However, MTCs could be claimed as proprietary information, and therefore companies might not be able to meet the obligation of Article 3g.
- Small quantities of low-value items: no carve outs for these shipments are contemplated. As an example, shipping a small number of screws, spacers, nuts, or other fasteners to a repair center in the EU from the US, where the value of the items is negligible. The effort and cost of tracing a hundred individual fasteners to their respective production batches and furnishing an MTC for each greatly exceeds their value.

We understand that some of these concerns are being addressed in an updated draft FAQs which includes examples of additional documents that can be considered evidence, as well as clarifications on the application of prohibition based on the date where products where procured/manufactured. Nevertheless, we call on the **European Commission to provide further guidance on the certification requirement in Article 3g**, and specifically regarding the following issues:

- 1. Clarification on whether any exclusions for older products will be considered.
- 2. Clarifications on what other types of documentation may meet the EU requirement if MTCs cannot be used due to their proprietary nature, in some cases (e.g. origin declarations, attestations of the metal supplier, invoice(s), quality certificates(s), declarations by the manufacturer, clauses in implemented contracts or purchase orders, etc.)
- 3. **Clarifications on how Customs will implement the evidence requirement.** A harmonized approach across Member States to avoid different evidentiary requirements would be of utmost importance. Additionally, if the evidence is not sufficient for customs authorities, what are the rectification possibilities for importers?
- 4. Specifically, for the aerospace sector, **clarification and/or exclusion for scenarios involving Aircraft on Ground (AOG)**, which is a scenario where an aircraft is grounded and is in urgent need of service. It is of utmost importance to avoid a standstill in the operations due to documentation clearance.
- 5. **Clarification on when companies would be in breach of the Regulation**. Would that happen when goods physically cross the EU territorial border or only when the goods are released for free circulation? Equally, clarifications on who will be liable in case of violation of the regulation are needed (e.g. carrier/forwarder, the sender, the consignee, others)
- 6. **Clarifications as to the definition of purchase contract.** Is the purchase contract defined according to general sales contract definition, which comes about through two matching declarations of intent or with the payment for the goods?
- 7. **Clarifications as to treatment of imports from Partner countries identified in Annex VIII.** Those countries are identified as having similar export measures as the EU. Therefore, would the imports of iron and steel products shipped from these countries be exempted from the import requirements?

To conclude, the industry remains committed to support the effort to avoid any potential circumvention of sanctions while, at the same time, ensuring that companies can realistically comply with any certification requirement.
