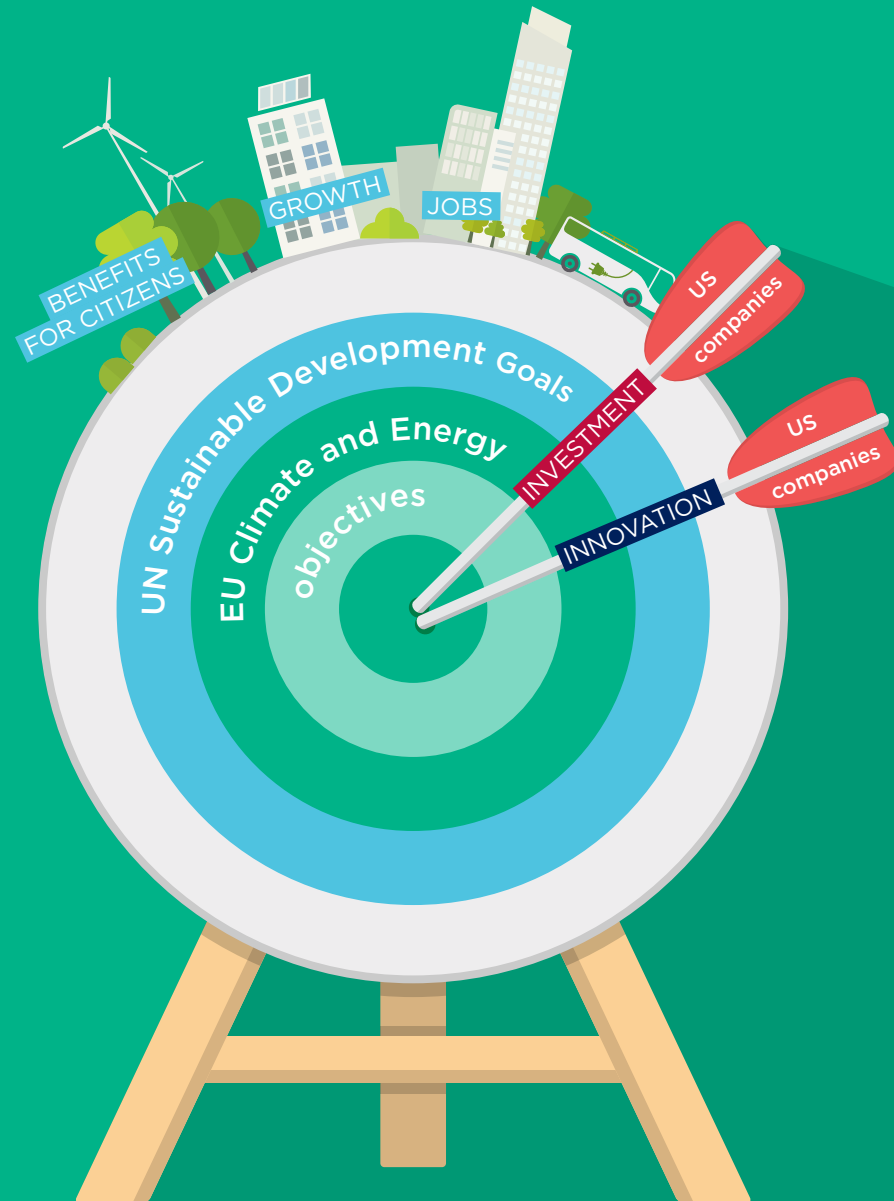


US companies aiming for a cleaner future
