Jill Wyant is Executive Vice President and President of Global Regions and Global Healthcare for Ecolab Inc., the global leader in water, hygiene and energy technologies and services that protect people and vital resources.

Wyant leads Ecolab's \$5 billion Global Regions organisation, where she is responsible for the vision, strategy and general management skills to shape the next phase of growth for all the company's businesses internationally. In partnership with the Ecolab board and senior management, she laid out a sweeping strategy to transform international into the major growth engine and in 2018, doubled topline growth. She also oversees Ecolab's \$1 billion Global Healthcare business, which provides a broad portfolio of innovative, digitally-enabled infection prevention programmes to hospitals, clinics and health systems. During Wyant's three-year tenure in the business, sales have increased 50% to nearly \$1 billion as a result of her aggressive focus on organic growth, transformative acquisitions and innovation.

Previously, Wyant was executive vice president and president of Ecolab's Global Food & Beverage, Global Healthcare and Global Life Sciences businesses, a \$2.5 billion portfolio. She has held several leadership positions within Ecolab, including executive vice president and president of the Global Food & Beverage sector, senior vice president and general manager of Food & Beverage in North America and Latin America, and led Food & Beverage in the Asia Pacific region. Wyant joined Ecolab in 2009 as vice president of Global Strategic Planning. Prior to Ecolab, she held multiple leadership positions at General Electric.

Wyant is active in the Minneapolis-St. Paul community. She serves on the board of overseers of the Carlson School of Management at the University of Minnesota and has served on the board of directors of the Greater Twin Cities United Way. She is a member of the Minnesota Women's Economic Roundtable and The Committee of 200, a professional organization of female entrepreneurs and corporate leaders. She is also a member of World 50, a private community for CEOs and C-level executives at global organizations to discover better ideas, share experiences and build relationships that make a lasting impact.

Wyant earned an MBA degree with highest honors from the University of Chicago Booth School of Business, and graduated summa cum laude from the University of St. Thomas with bachelor's degrees in international marketing and Japanese studies. She and her family reside in Zurich, Switzerland.
